ST. JOHN'S JESUIT HIGH SCHOOL & ACADEMY BLOODBORNE PATHOGENS EXPOSURE POLICY

Below are the guidelines which will be followed by St. John's Jesuit High School & Academy in the event that students or staff are exposed to blood or body fluids.

- In accordance with ADA and Section 504, we do not ask about students' or staff members' infectious disease status.
- To safeguard everyone, all staff are trained in and required to practice standard precautions with every student. Students are also taught age-appropriate standard precautions.
- Whenever there is a blood spill or exposure to body fluids, the school policies and follow-up actions assume all body fluids involved are potentially infectious.
- All students are required to have the hepatitis B vaccines.
- If your child is exposed to potentially infectious body fluids, you will be notified immediately and encouraged to contact your physician or the local health department for appropriate post-exposure testing for HIV, HBV, and HCV.
