

The boys are asked to wear St. John's Jesuit High School and Academy clothing, whenever possible. In the event of colder weather, jackets and sweatshirts/hoodies need not be SJJ-themed. Anything deemed inappropriate will **not** be allowed. Please remind your son that he is a representative of his school and community at all times, including through his appearance.

While in the city, the boys need to wear jeans, cargo/khaki pants, or cargo/khaki/madras shorts (weather permitting). Sweatpants or athletic (gym) pants or shorts are only allowed on the bus ride from/to Toledo and in the hotel.

A long-sleeve t-shirt or a sweatshirt as well as a lined jacket should be in the boys' possession at all times. The boat ride can be especially cold, so a winter hat and gloves are also recommended.

iPads, laptop computers, video game systems, and personal DVD players should **not** be brought on the trip. Digital cameras, cell phones, and iPods are OK, but are the sole responsibility of the owner. We strongly recommend against bringing expensive headphones. Lost or damaged personal items and electronics will not be replaced by SJJ.

Any medical requirements or concerns **must** be cleared by the nurse at SJJ. Necessary (daily) and/or situational (motion sickness, etc.) medicines should be stored in a **sealed, labeled plastic bag** with **clear instructions** included. It is best to print out any instructions and store them with the medicine inside the bag. Medicines **must** be in the possession of a chaperone, not the student.

Comfortable shoes
Lined jacket (heavier than a windbreaker)
Winter hat and gloves
Sleeping clothes
"Morning bathroom routine" necessities (other than what the hotel will provide)
Meal/Snack money (rest stops, Lincoln Park Zoo, Portillo's, Navy Pier)
Time-telling device (watch or cell phone)
Medical necessities (see last paragraph above)

Baseball cap
Pillow/Small blanket
iPod
Cell phone (if student has a watch)
Digital camera
Basic snack food
Playing cards (no poker sets or gambling)
Reading material
Additional spending money

THINGS NOT TO BRING:

iPad
Laptop
DVD player
Video game systems
Excessive candy/pop/junk food/energy drinks
Inappropriate clothing
Anything you/they cannot risk being broken or lost
